She got the title of Professor in 2020. She has been working as a book and paper conservator since 1990 and as an academic teacher at the Department of Conservation of Book and Paper since 1993, expert of Polish Minister of Culture and National Heritage since 2004, member of the board of European Network for Conservation-Restoration Education (ENCoRE) 2008 – 2018, member of the editorial board of *Notes Konserwatorski* and *Archeion*, member of the board of European Research Centre for Book and Paper Conservation-Restoration since 2010
